Next Gen	28,600	NextGen Ministries is more than just programs—it's the spiritual foundation for the next generation, from infancy through high school and into young adulthood. We are shaping future leaders and helping build a lifelong faith that will impact generations to come.
Growth	\$18,000	Growth Ministries is where faith becomes family. Through Bible studies for men, women, couples, singles, support groups like GriefShare and Celebrate Recovery, and Life Groups meeting in homes and throughout the community, people find encouragement, healing, friendship, and spiritual growth while doing life together.
Worship Svcs	\$16,600	Worship Services Ministries helps create meaningful and life-changing worship experiences every week through the dedication of greeters, ushers, volunteers, singers, musicians, and worship arts teams. From the moment someone arrives until the final song is sung, every person serving plays an important role in helping others feel welcomed, inspired, and connected to God.
Outreach	\$120,000	Outreach Ministries is the hands and feet of Jesus in our community and beyond. Through our Peace Center food pantry, community engagement events, seasonal outreaches like Kids Summer Blast, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter celebrations, as well as missionary support and mission trips, we are meeting practical needs while sharing the hope and love of Christ. Every act of kindness becomes an opportunity to change lives, strengthen families, and bring people closer to God—both near and far.
Capital Projects	\$17,900	Capital Projects help prepare the way for the future by creating and improving spaces where lives can be changed for generations to come. From building upgrades to expanding ministry opportunities, every project is an investment in reaching more people, strengthening our church family, and creating environments where people can encounter God and grow in their faith.
Operations	\$868,900	Operations Ministries provides the essential behind-the-scenes support that keeps every ministry running smoothly each week. From utilities, janitorial services, IT and web support, to meeting important government and safety requirements, these everyday needs help create a safe, welcoming, and effective environment for ministry to happen. Though often unseen, Operations plays a vital role in supporting everything we do as a church.
Personnel	\$2,430,000	Personnel expenses support an incredible team of 34 dedicated employees who faithfully serve across five locations, four campuses, and the Peace Center food pantry. From administrative staff to ministry directors, leaders, and pastors, this team works together every day to care for people, strengthen ministries, and help fulfill the mission of the church. These expenses also provide essential support such as health insurance, workers compensation, and payroll taxes, allowing our staff to continue serving with excellence, passion, and heart.
