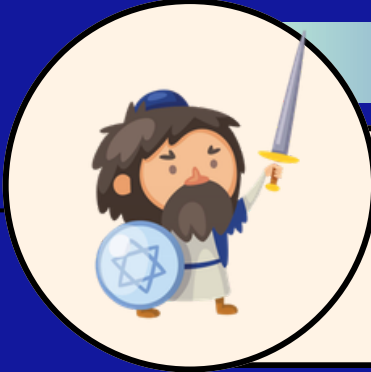

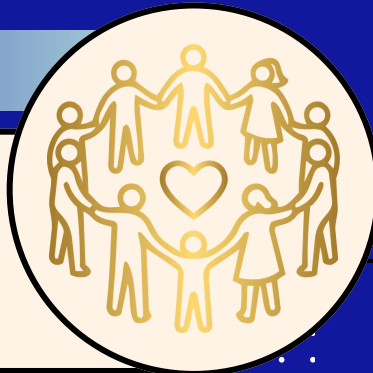


To'Dot Tea

HIS DIVINE CALLING

ROMANS

8:28

Last month we began our readings in Bamidbar, or Numbers. Bamidbar means “in the wilderness.” At the very beginning of this portion we see ADONAI begin to call out people by name for various tasks. This specificity raises several questions in our own lives. What is our calling? What does it mean to be “called by G-d”?

At this point, the Israelites are camped in the desert around Mount Sinai where they received the 10 Commandments. They are preparing to travel to the Promised Land for the first time. In this portion, G-d commands Moses and his brother Aaron to do a census so that G-d can assign tasks to the people. Some would be responsible for packing up the camp and others to lead the military. The Levites would be responsible for the Tabernacle. Each tribe, each family, each man was given an assignment. Some would say, they were “called” by the Lord to do these tasks. But is that really what a calling is, to be assigned a task?

In Romans 8:28 we read, “Now we know that all things work together for good for those who love G-d, who are called according to His purpose.” There was a time in my life when I saw this happen. It was last year in August when I tried out for a main role in my school’s showcase. When we got the results, it turned out I didn’t get the part I was expecting. I was disappointed because I felt like I did a great job, and it was overlooked. It made me wonder why I wasn’t good enough for the role.

But then, Mrs. Ginger, who is the director of the Purim play at CBM, asked me if I wanted to be Esther in the play this year! I was very excited about this new opportunity and very gladly accepted the role. I felt a sense of joy because even though I didn’t get the part I wanted at school, G-d provided me with a greater plan to glorify Him. And I could truly see in this situation all things working together for good for those who love G-d and who are called.

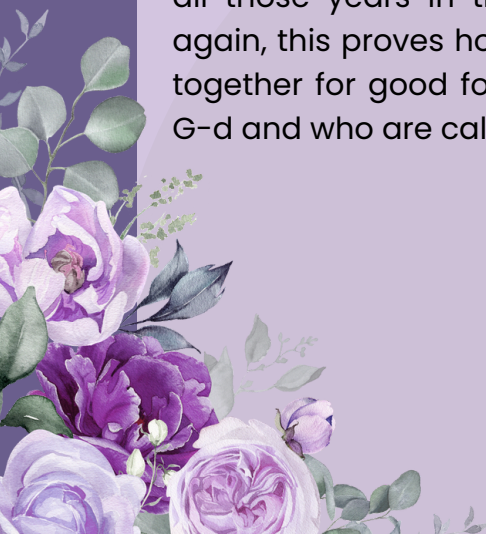
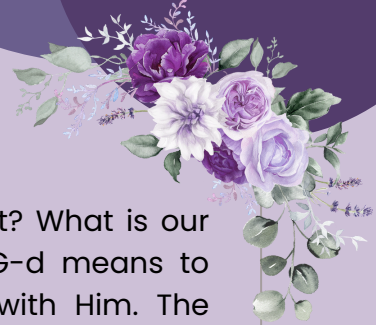

We can also see this in the life of Amos. Amos was tending his flock when ADONAI commanded him to prophesy to Israel. ADONAI wanted Bnei-Yisrael to turn back to Him and away from their sins. So, why did G-d trust Amos to do this? And how did Amos know that it was G-d asking him? The answer is that G-d trusted Amos because they already had a relationship! And based on this relationship, the Lord gave him this task.

Another amazing example is when G-d assigned Esther the task of stopping the annihilation of His People. Now, she had no idea that was the task to which she was being called when she was taken from her home to join the king's harem. But five years later, Mordechai challenged her by saying, "If you keep quiet now, help and freedom for the Jews will come from another place. But you and your father's family will all die. And who knows, maybe you have been chosen to be the queen for such a time as this?" (Esther 4.14) In other words, if Esther decided not to accept this assignment, G-d would have given it to someone else. But Esther chose to pray and fast with everyone in her community, showing that she had maintained her relationship with G-d all those years in the palace. Once again, this proves how all things work together for good for those who love G-d and who are called.

So, why is this important? What is our calling? Being called by G-d means to enter into a relationship with Him. The calling is the relationship! Our relationship with Him is what makes us called; the tasks are just things He tells us to do for His purpose. Our choice to give our hearts to Him, to love and obey Him, establishes this relationship. ADONAI then gives us certain tasks so that we as believers can show His Light to the world. And because of this relationship with Him, we "... declare the praises of Him who called us out of darkness, and into His wonderful light." (1 Peter 2:9) Matthew 5:16 says it this way, "In the same way, let your light shine before men so they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

Now, how do we enter into this relationship with ADONAI so that we are called to His purpose? It is only by Yeshua's sacrifice that we can. His death and resurrection allow us to have a direct relationship with ADONAI. Every week in our Shabbat service we read I John 1:9, "If we confess our sins, we find that He is faithful and just to forgive our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. The blood of Yeshua the Messiah cleanses us from all sin." When we give our hearts to ADONAI through the sacrifice of Messiah on our behalf, He will use us in ways that we wouldn't have imagined, and trust us with His assignments, regardless of our flaws. G-d is calling you to a relationship with Him! As it says in 2 Timothy 1: 9, "He has saved us and called us with a holy calling - not because of our deeds but because of His own purpose and grace. This grace was given to us in Messiah Yeshua."

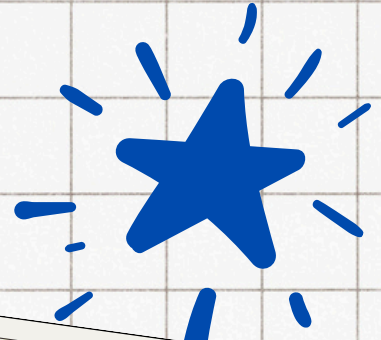
