SVDP IN THEIR SHOES

St. Vincent de Paul is hosting a lunch event called 'In Their Shoes' to raise awareness of the less fortunate in our community on [March 15th](#) from 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm. Parishioners will be provided with a basic meal typically available to those on a tight budget. The meal may include a clear soup, bread, and/or other low-cost ingredients. COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND

Some in our parish can no longer join us physically at Mass due to illness, age, mobility challenges, or other circumstances. The livestream helps them stay connected to the liturgy, but nothing compares with physical presence: a visit from a community member and receiving Holy Communion.

To better serve our homebound community members we are taking two steps:

1. Identifying who would like a visit. If you, or someone you know (a family member, friend, neighbour, or acquaintance) is homebound and would appreciate receiving Holy Communion at home, please contact the parish office. We are building a list of interested people, so that we can reach out and arrange visits.
2. Identifying Volunteer Ministers. Next weekend, we will invite parishioners that are interested in volunteering for this ministry to register - more information to follow. Once we get a critical mass, we will arrange for training and for visits (in pairs) to be made to those in our community who are homebound.
