SAFETY

- Students will always be supervised, including REC, free time, and while in the cabins/campgrounds area.
- Students are not permitted to leave the campsite.
- Check-ins will occur during the day, every day.
- Staff and leaders will be present at the swimming area. All camp participants will be requested to follow the instructions of the camp.

GUIDELINES and MEDICAL RELEASE/CODE OF CONDUCT:

- Please familiarize yourself with all camp guidelines and rules.
- As part of your registration, you completed a medical release form. This provides our staff and camp nurse with emergency medical information. If that information has changed, please contact our Student Ministry Staff.
- Additionally, as part of your registration process, you signed the Code of Conduct. Please be aware of the potential consequences of behavior that violates that commitment.

CELL PHONES

- There will be no cell phone use allowed this year at Creek Camp.
- Students will be allowed to bring them for calls/text to parents but no other uses.
- We want this to be a time of zero distractions while we learn about Jesus and connect with community
- Phones will be collected and charged in a central location where the leader is.
- Parents, have a conversation with your student(s) about responsible use while at camp and how they can have an intentional week connecting with God more than their social feeds.

Creek Camp Guidelines and Rules

CAMP RULES ARE AN EXTENSION OF THE STUDENT MINISTRY CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Students are expected to participate in all activities: Worship, Small Groups, REC, and Free Time.
2. Modesty in clothing is expected. Bring an appropriate 1-piece/Tankini swimsuit. You're responsible for reading and following our Summer Must Haves Handout.
3. Any damage to your room is the responsibility of the students assigned to that room.
4. Lights Out means just that. No leaving your cabin during lights out hours (each night until 6:30am).
5. Students are not allowed to leave the cabin or the group. The only exception is WITH adult supervision.
6. No guys in girl's rooms and No girls in guy's rooms. Stay in your own cabin!
7. Respect the privacy and property of others. Stay out of other people's stuff!
8. No pranking, hazing, or bullying...period. We have a zero-tolerance policy in regard to pranks.

Failure to comply with the Camp Guidelines and Rules may result in being sent home at your Parent's Expense.
