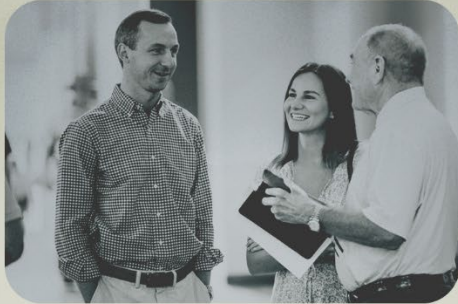

Teach One Another

- Throughout the year, each Connect Group will have opportunities to visit and teach in their Legacy Link partner group.
- This allows younger teachers to grow through experience while seasoned teachers encourage, coach, and invest in the next generation of leaders.

Encourage One Another

- Teachers connect outside of Sunday mornings through coffee, lunch, phone calls, or other intentional conversations.
- These relationships provide wisdom, accountability, prayer, and friendship that strengthen both leaders.

Do Life Together

Legacy Link groups intentionally spend time together beyond Sunday mornings.

- Ideas include:
 - Shared meals
 - Fellowship events
 - Mission projects
 - Church events together

These moments create meaningful friendships across generations.

Pray for One Another

- Every generation has different joys and challenges.
- Legacy Link groups commit to regularly praying for one another by sharing prayer requests, sending notes of encouragement, and celebrating how God is at work.

VISION/GOAL - every person who says yes to Jesus has someone to walk with them.

Matthew 28:18-20 - *"All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."*

2 Timothy 2:2 – *"What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, commit to faithful men who will be able to teach others also"*

- Paul -> Timothy -> Faithful Men (People) -> Others = 4 Generations of Discipleship
- The core message is the ongoing, generational passing of the Gospel, not just individual learning
- Faithfulness over Talent

Walking with someone as they understand the Gospel, grow in habits, obey Jesus, and disciple others.

ReConnect Sunday - August 16, 2026.

The Purpose of **ReConnect** Sunday is a focused opportunity for **every Connect Group to intentionally reach out to their roster and prospect list** and **personally invite people** back for a special Sunday. On this day, each Connect Group teacher will clearly present the gospel and include a baptism emphasis, creating space for people to respond and take next steps.

This is a shepherding moment and an evangelistic moment. It is about reconnecting people to biblical community and clearly pointing them to Jesus.

The Hook

To help create a welcoming and celebratory environment, Krispy Kreme donuts will be shipped in for the day. Each Connect Group will place an order based on how many dozen they anticipate needing. On August 16, groups will pick up their donuts from their assigned station: Lighthouse 3rd Floor, Adult Ministry Building Coffee Area, & Worship Center Foyer

There will also be foyer setups with Connect Group backdrops, bistro tables, and donut tables to help create energy and visibility across our campuses.
