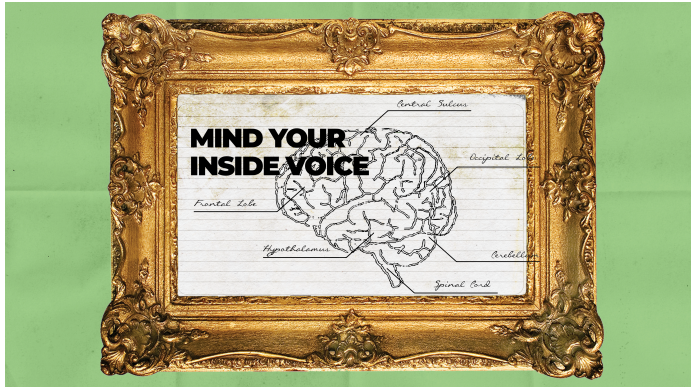

Why is it tempting to say, “no one gets me...not even God?”

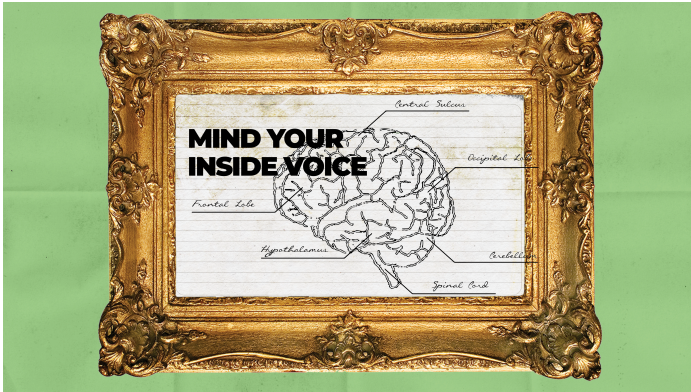
Take some time now and prayerfully think about the impact of following passage:

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“G-I-G-O” = Garbage In, Garbage Out

When we have garbage thoughts about God, we will have garbage thoughts about ourselves.

Today, we want to look at what is the truth in those times when you feel like “no one gets me...not even God.”

If what we think about God is wrong, then what we think about our relationship with God will be wrong.

The truth: If no one else ever gets you, the truth is that God always gets you.

The truth is that God does love you and even promises never to leave you nor forsake you (Hebrews 13:5b).

We can know that God gets us, because God knows us from our beginning.

Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.
Jeremiah 1:5 (ESV)

We can know that God gets us, because God knows the plans He has for us.

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.
Jeremiah 29:11 (ESV)
