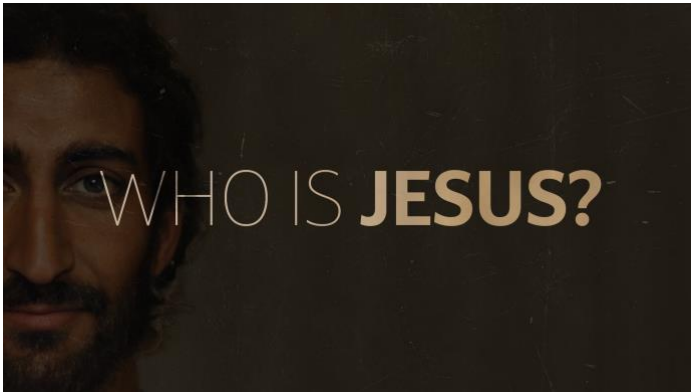

If Jesus really is the only way to God, what does that say about His love for us?

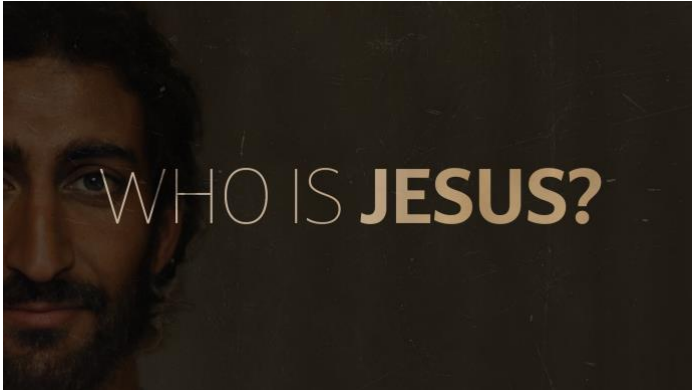
What would it look like for you personally to “type Jesus into the GPS of your heart” and start following Him?

John 13:35 (NLT)

Jesus has never been unclear about who He is.

John 14:6 (NLT)

There's only one road, and His name is Jesus.

If you had really known me, you would know who my Father is. From now on, you do know him and have seen him!

John 14:7 (NLT)

Just believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me. Or at least believe because of the work you have seen me do.

John 14:11 (NLT)

Just believe.

Only Jesus offers a relationship with God.

Jesus says: **"It is finished. Come to me."**

Jesus already paid the toll so we can go straight to the Father.
