Here is the passage we discussed in the message, broken into sections. Under each one, think about what opportunities you have to obey God's instructions in each area:

Keep on loving each other as brothers and sisters. (How can I show real love and care for the people of my church family?)

Don't forget to show hospitality to strangers, for some who have done this have entertained angels without realizing it! (Strangers are those outside my family and church.)

Remember those in prison, as if you were there yourself. (We can also expand this to also include anyone who is alone, shut-in or isolated.)

Remember also those being mistreated, as if you felt their pain in your own bodies. (Those who need compassion and advocacy.)

Give honor to marriage, and remain faithful to one another in marriage. God will surely judge people who are immoral and those who commit adultery." (By my example and words, how can I help others see the value of marriage and family for God's honor? Remember too, if we sin in this area, God will forgive if we genuinely admit our fault and repent (change). See 1 John 1:9.)

Don't love money; be satisfied with what you have. (Choosing to be content and generous with all I have.)
