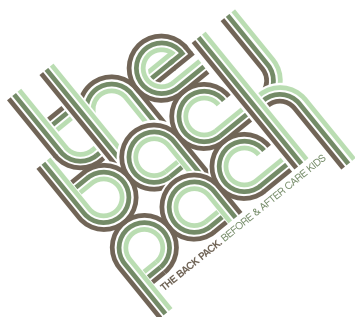

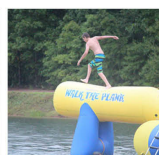
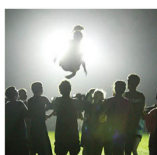

BAPTISM INFORMATION MEETINGS



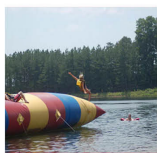
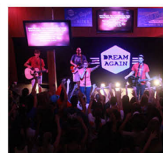
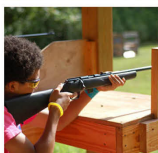
