Perspective - to see clearly as things really are.

Good perspective doesn’t change reality; it sets us up to face it!

Build good perspective with these three things:

1. An accurate understanding of God informed by the Bible.

He is omni-loving

He is omnipresent

“You go before me and follow me. You place your hand of blessing on my head.”

He is omnipotent

He is omniscient

2. Ongoing accountability with others who truly follow Him.
