## MEALS ON WHEELS

Meals On Wheels provides a warm meal once a week, on Thursday mornings, to members of our church and community in a time of need. Members dealing with health issues, birth of a child, loss of a loved one, or financial constraints are just a few examples of ways Meals On Wheels can help

**Drivers/deliverers: Once every 9 weeks (or every week if you desire) deliver meals, this usually takes less than an hour**

**Cooks: Be part of a team of four that cooks every 9 weeks. You can bring your dish the Wednesday night before and leave it in the fridge for the next day**

**Team Leader: Oversee your group, and make sure that everyone remembers their task .**

## KITCHEN

The Kitchen Ministry coordinates Wednesday night meals for the CONGREGATION and guests, and provides for the general needs of the kitchen

**Wednesday night meal: prepare a meal, serve food, and clean up after the meal**

**Kitchen Care: Help with the basic care beyond the scope of the cleaning crew (example - washing towels)**
