

Psalm 119:89-176

memory verse:

"You are my shelter and my shield and I put
my hope in Your Word." - Psalm 119:114 CSB

Observations and Principles from Psalm 119:

- God's Word has provided wisdom to prevent us from wandering, worrying, stressing and regressing to behaviors that do not line up with His Word.
- Verse 97: "How I love Your instructions." Love. Does. Stuff.
- Verse 93: "I will never forget thy precepts: for with them thou hast quickened me."
 - Hebrew word = Kha-ya
 - Definition = restored my life, given me life, sustained my life, to revive me from sickness, discouragement, faintness, to refresh, to cause to grow, to FLOURISH to repair, to nourish up and to save.
- Verse 124: "I am your servant; deal with me in unfailing love, and teach me Your decrees."
 - Hebrew word = lamad
 - Definition = to instruct, train, ALSO: to goad...as in discipline or guide an animal with a sharp rod.
 - It is for stubborn animals that are slow or obstinate to obey direction and doing what is desired of them.
- Kicking against the goad inflicts pain to the kicker.

The Lord might be using something sharp and painful to direct your life.
