- Rejoice with those who rejoice. (vs.15)
- Mourn with those who mourn. (vs.15)
- Live in harmony. (vs.16)
- Do not repay anyone evil for evil. (vs.17)
- Live at peace with everyone. (vs. 18)
- Never avenge yourself, leave room for the wrath of God. (vs.19)
