### Week 3

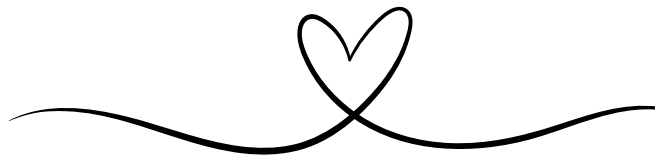
- Developing daily spiritual disciplines transforms how we think, act and believe.
