

Psalm 119: 1-56**Psalm Teaches Us:**

- The Priority of God's Word
- The Purpose of God's Word
- The Profit of God's Word

Top Ten Verses: (between 1-56)

1. "Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) are the undefiled (the upright, truly sincere, and blameless) in the way [of the revealed will of God], who walk (order their conduct and conversation) in the law of the Lord (the whole of God's revealed will)." AMPC (vs. 1)

"You're blessed when you stay on course, walking steadily on the road revealed by God. You're blessed when you follow his directions, doing your best to find him." The Message

2. "Oh, that my actions would consistently reflect your principles!" (vs. 5)
3. "I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you." (vs. 11)
4. "I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways." (vs. 15)
5. "I lie in the dust, completely discouraged; revive me by your word." (vs.25)
6. "Keep me from lying to myself;
give me the privilege of knowing your instructions." (vs. 29)
7. "Give me understanding and I will obey your law;
I will put it into practice with all my heart." (vs. 34)
8. "Turn my eyes from worthless things, and give me life through your Word." (vs. 37)
9. "Your promise revives me; it comforts me in all my troubles." (vs. 50)
Quickened: Kha-ya (haya!) give life, nourish, restore health, repair, recover,
revive from sickness, discouragement and faintness
10. "This is my happy way of life: obeying your commandments." (vs.56)
