Isaiah | Debbie Stuart | Week 4

If you set up barriers of pride, self-reliance and an unrepentant heart, you will hinder the progress of your soul and you will forfeit the plan of God for your life.

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 25

- God offers Himself as our strength, refuge (vs. 4), shadow (vs. 5), shelter (vs.4) and rest from oppression (vs. 4-6). Human sorrow is relieved by God (vs. 6-8).

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 26

- "You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, whose thoughts are fixed on you." (vs. 3 NLT)
- "You will keep the mind that is dependent on you in perfect peace, for it is trusting in you." (CSB)
- "You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you." (ESV)
- "People with their minds set on you, you keep perfectly whole, steady on their feet, because they keep at it and don't quit. Depend on God and keep at it because in the Lord God you have a sure thing." (MSG)
- Peace is not the absence of problems; it is the presence of God. Peace has a name...it's JESUS!
- Application: Define words. Make "jobs" column. List action steps: HOW will you keep your mind stayed?

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 27

- God does not punish us for our sin to make us suffer, but to make us better and fruitful.

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 28

- "The bed you have made is too short to lie on. The blankets are too narrow to cover you." (vs. 20)
- Outside of Christ there is neither peace nor comfort, nor rest for our souls.

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 29

- "These people say they are mine. They honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far away." (vs. 13) They are lazy, fake, disingenuous, uncaring about the things of God.
- ESV Study Bible - "They need a radical awakening." It's the opposite of Quiet Quitting!

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 30

- "Only in returning to me and waiting for me will you be saved. In quietness and confidence is your strength. But you would have none of it." (vs. 15)

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 31

- Destruction is certain for those who look to _____ for help, trusting their _____ and _____ instead of looking to the Lord, the Holy One of Israel. (vs. 1)

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 32

- "Listen, you women who lie around in lazy ease." (vs. 9)
- "Tremble you women of ease; throw off your unconcern." (vs. 11)
