Isaiah | Debbie Stuart | Week 7

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 49

- “He has hidden me in the shadow of His hand. I am like a sharp arrow in His quiver.” (2)
- He said: “You are my servant. You will bring me glory.”
- I said: “My work seems so useless. I have spent all my strength for nothing, it has no purpose. YET I will leave it all in the Lord’s hands and I WILL trust God for my reward.”

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 50

- The Sovereign LORD has given me a well-instructed tongue, to know the word that sustains the weary. He wakens me morning by morning, wakens my ear to listen like one being instructed. (4)
- The Sovereign LORD has opened my ears; I have not been rebellious, I have not turned away. (5)

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 51

- God speaks comfort to His people in their oppressed condition (which they caused).
- The Lord exhorts His people to LISTEN and WAKE UP!

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 52

- The Lord will go ahead of you, and He will protect you from behind.
- God calls His people to ARISE and SHAKE OFF the past and live for the future.

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 53

- Foretells the suffering and death of the Messiah, which brings eternal life to all people.

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 54

- “Enlarge the place of your tent, and let the curtains of your habitations be stretched out; do not hold back; lengthen your cords and strengthen your stakes.” (2)
- God plants hope in their hearts and promises to bless and make them fruitful.
- “No weapon formed against you will succeed”... (17)

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 55

- “Seek the LORD while He may be found; call on Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake their ways and the unrighteous their thoughts. Let them turn to the LORD, and He will have mercy on them, and to our God, for He will freely pardon.” (6-7)
- “For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the LORD. “As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.” (8-9)
- “You will indeed go out with joy and be peacefully guided...” (12)

Principles from Isaiah Ch. 56

- A call to live a righteous life, obey God’s Word, maintain a repentant and humble heart.
