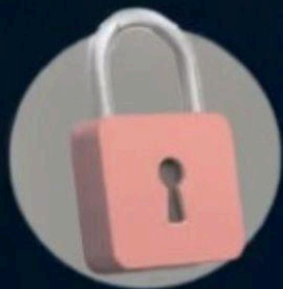
## **REFLECTION**

**Acts 2:1-21**

In Acts 2:1–21, the coming of the Holy Spirit transforms a frightened and uncertain group of disciples into bold witnesses of God’s love. The rushing wind and tongues of fire are signs that God’s presence cannot be confined to one place, language, or people. Pentecost reminds us that the Spirit speaks in ways that people can truly hear and understand, meeting humanity in the midst of diversity rather than erasing it. Peter’s words from the prophet Joel reveal that God’s Spirit is poured out on all people—young and old, women and men, servants and free alike. This passage challenges the church to become a community marked by inclusion, courage, and hope instead of fear and division. Even in moments of uncertainty or transition, Pentecost proclaims that God is still creating something new through ordinary people empowered by the Spirit. The story invites us to listen for where the Spirit is moving today and to join in God’s ongoing work of renewal in the world.

## **DISCUSSION**

1. What is one story you can tell about how the Holy Spirit has been active in your life?
2. We talk about being Easter people, how can we extend that to being Pentecost people?
3. What can we learn from Pentecost to apply to the 21st-century church?
4. What does it mean for us to live inspired by God’s Spirit?
