WORDS OF MEDITATION

“Call narratives in the Hebrew Bible typically describe an encounter between the deity and an individual, followed by a commission—or in Abram’s case, a promise. Likewise, if you are reading this, it is probable that you, too, have experienced a sense of God calling you to go: to seminary, to serve, to proclaim. These stories usually center on the person summoned, giving little to no attention to the impact on their families—just as God’s call to Abram notably omits Sarai and Lot.”

PRACTICE

Think about a way that you can focus on God, who blesses us in unimaginable ways. Now think about something in your life that you need to shift your focus from in order to follow that calling that God has on your life. Pray to God about how you will say, “I Will.”

REFLECTION**Genesis 12:1-9**

In Genesis 12:1–9, Abram is called by God to leave behind everything familiar and journey toward an unknown future. His willingness to go without knowing all the details demonstrates a profound trust in God's promises. This passage reminds us that faith is often less about certainty and more about obedience in the midst of uncertainty. God's call to Abram is not only for his own blessing but also so that he may become a blessing to others. Along the way, Abram builds altars and worships, marking moments where he recognizes God's presence and faithfulness. His journey encourages us to listen for God's call, trust in God's guidance, and remember that our faithful response can have a lasting impact beyond ourselves.

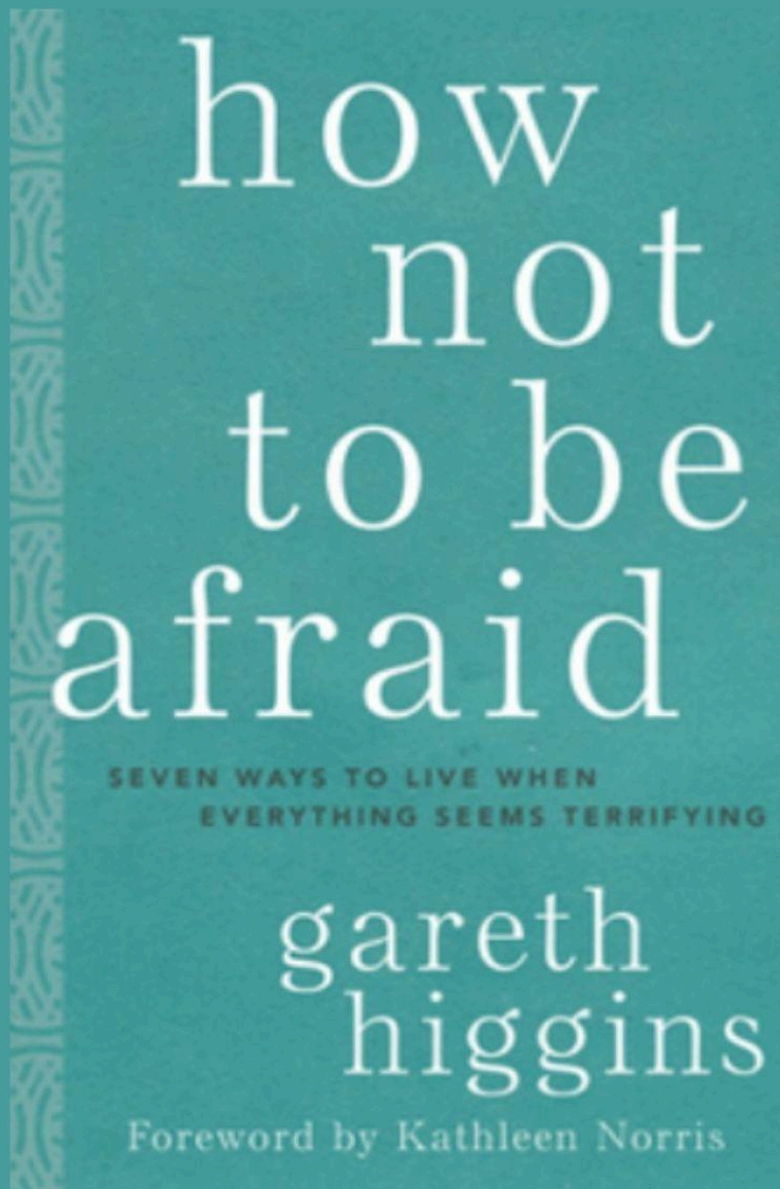
DISCUSSION
