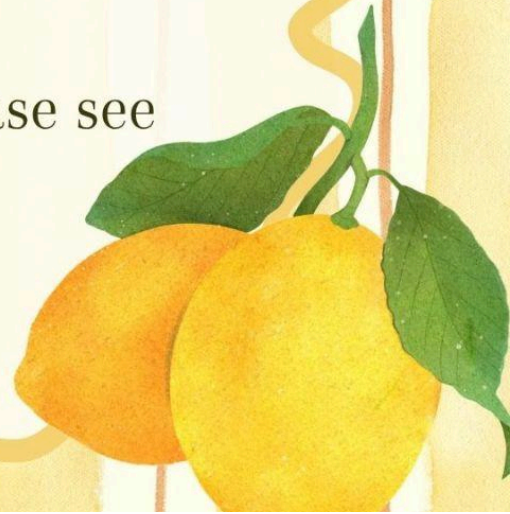

PRACTICE

Say the words, “God chooses to listen to me.” Now think of a circumstance where life seems difficult, whether it is something that you are currently experiencing or experienced in the past. Now say again, “God chooses to listen to me.” How does this change your viewpoint of the situation?

REFLECTION

Genesis 18:1-15

In Genesis 18:1–15, Abraham and Sarah receive unexpected visitors who bring an even more unexpected promise: Sarah will bear a son in her old age. The story reminds us that God often works beyond the limits we place on what is possible. Sarah’s laughter reveals both her doubt and the deep longing she may have carried for years. Yet God does not withdraw the promise because of her skepticism; instead, God responds with a question that echoes throughout Scripture: “Is anything too wonderful for the Lord?” This passage invites us to consider where we have given up hope or assumed that certain possibilities are beyond reach. God’s faithfulness is not constrained by human timelines, circumstances, or expectations. Even when we struggle to believe, God continues to call us toward trust in the new things God is bringing to life.

DISCUSSION

1. Where in your life do you find yourself laughing like Sarah—not because you are joyful, but because God’s promise seems too surprising or too good to be true?
2. How do you distinguish between healthy skepticism and a lack of trust in God?
3. Sarah denied laughing because she was afraid. How does fear sometimes affect our honesty with God or others?

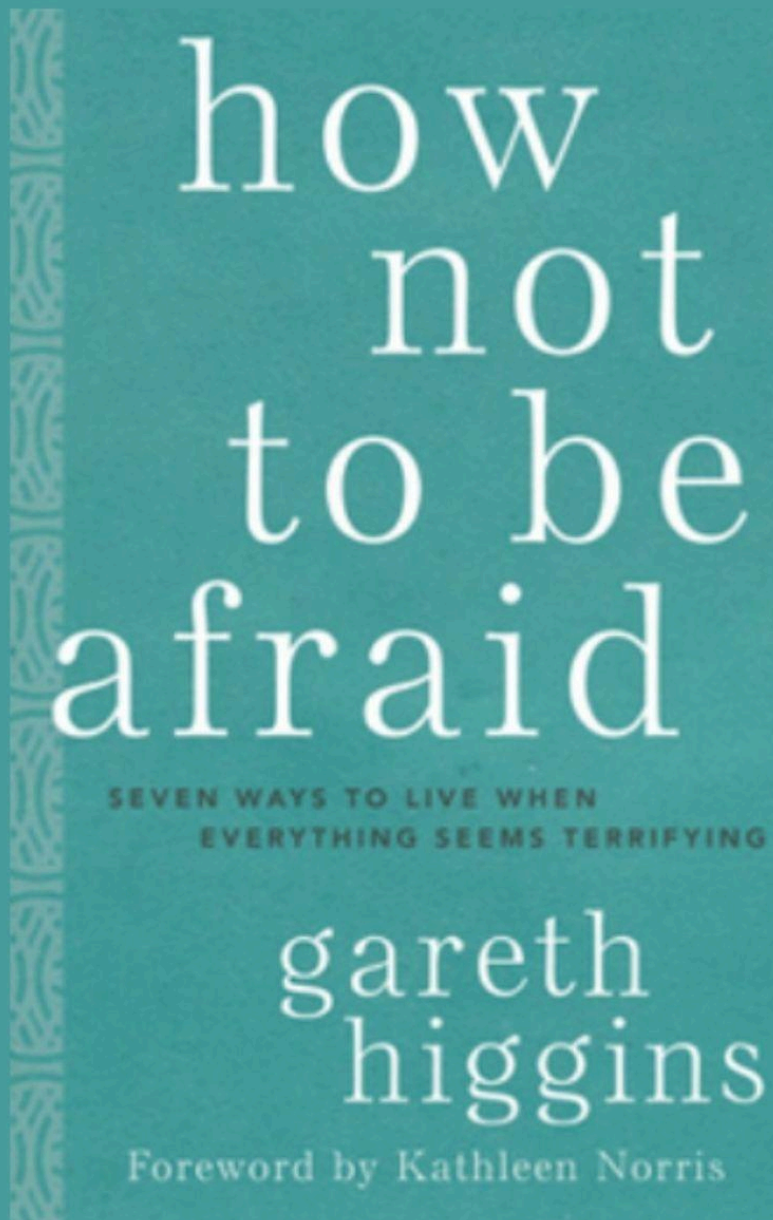

We need two volunteers, for two days, to answer phones. Please sign up below.

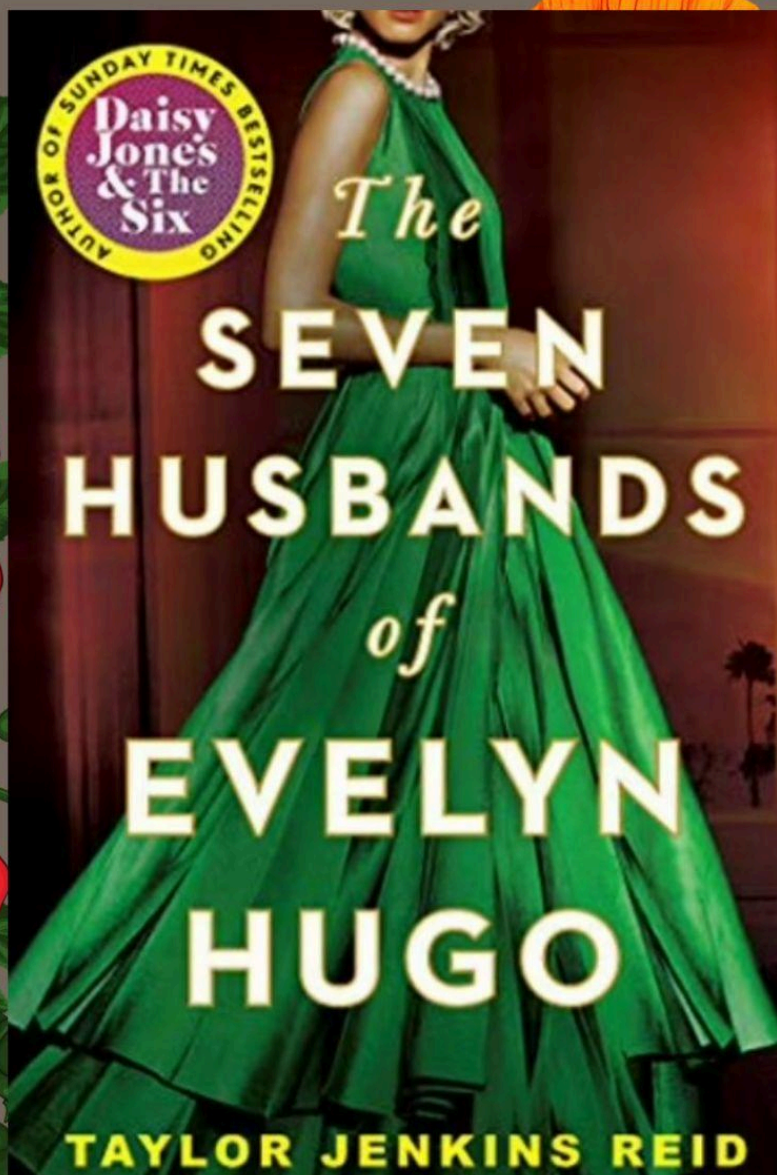

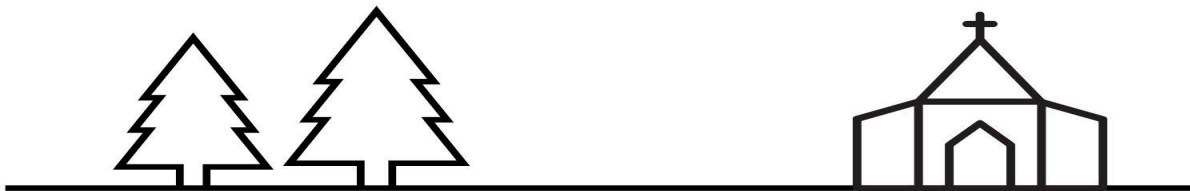
