Creekside supports 16 mission partners locally, nationally, and globally. These mission partners are an extension of our mission "to reach the world with Jesus one person at a time, by creating biblical disciples in relational environments." Creekside Missions coordinates short-term mission trips and also provides funds for disaster relief with partners such as IDES and Samaritan's Purse, benevolence, mission grants, and one-time project funds.

2024 BY THE NUMBERS



\$150K of annual support provided to our 16 missions partners, a 16% increase, plus:

- \$15K toward church planting
- \$10K to disaster relief + an additional \$8K given directly from congregation
- \$20K in church benevolence
- \$15K towards mission trips, one-time projects, and other activities

58 Creekside members experienced five mission trips, including 38 students, 7 Mission Partners visited Creekside.

Additional Missions related giving, above and beyond what came from the Missions fund, and includes the "investments" made by our church family.

MISSION PARTNERS

ALLIANCE DEFENDING FREEDOM

One of the leading Christian law firms committed to protecting religious freedom, free speech, marriage and family, parental rights, and the sanctity of life.

2024 Highlight: This year resulted in 66 litigation victories, 27 legislative victories, and 167 international victories, including freedom for 520 Christians from prison internationally.



CHRISTIAN ARABIC SERVICES

Since 1981, Christian Arabic Services has shared the gospel of Jesus Christ throughout the Arab world, through teaching and practical needs.

2024 Highlight: 18 new churches under construction, more than 43,000 children attended their Vacation Bible School, and witness to 6 Sudanese baptisms.



CENTRAL BRAZIL MISSION

Wants the people of the Amazon to know Jesus and to have "an abundant life" in and with Him.

2024 Highlight: There are now thirty "Project Amazon" churches in different villages and another 10 new villages right now are waiting and wanting a church.



CHOSEN REINS RANCH

Exists to glorify God by coming alongside the hurting with the love of Jesus and the truths of the Bible to offer hope and help to deal with life in a way that honors God.

2024 Highlight: A former counselee received her Biblical counseling certification and is counseling others at her church.

CENTRAL MYANMAR CHRISTIAN MISSION

Transforming lives for Christ by bringing the Good News to the unreached in central Myanmar and the whole country through effective evangelism, discipleship, and community development efforts.

2024 Highlight: Ongoing work on the girls' dormitory, completed a watering project serving hundreds of villagers, multiple evangelism events which resulted in about 200 baptisms.



CREEKSIDE FOSTER & ADOPTION MINISTRY

Providing support to help ensure a safe and stable environment for vulnerable children.

2024 Highlight: Provided wrap around support for 13 families in the form of encouragement and physical needs.



FLORIDA CHURCH PLANTERS

Supports the launch of independent Christian Churches in the state of Florida.

2024 Highlight: Celebrated the launch of Ru Church in Tampa and the launch of The Gathering in Naples and together have celebrated nearly 50 baptisms.



HIS CALL

Expanding the Kingdom of Christ in the Southern Region of Costa Rica and Northern Region of Panama through effective prayer, relational evangelism, pastoral care, expansion mentorship, and church planting.

2024 Highlight: Invested in training more than 30 ministry leaders to ensure their healthy spiritual growth.



FELLOWSHIP OF CHRISTIAN ATHLETES

Lead every coach and athlete into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ and his Church in Saint Johns County.

2024 Highlight: Distributed more than 250 Bibles to Coaches and Athletes who in turn have used them for bible studies with their teams to reach their teammates.



HIS EYES

Exists to see the world the way Jesus did, spiritually and physically - through clinic/medical work, church outreach opportunities, and children's after school programs in Honduras.

2024 Highlight: The children's after school program, called "The Milk Project" has five locations with over 200 children being served every day.



JOHNSON UNIVERSITY

Educating students for Christian ministries and other strategic vocations framed by the Great Commission in order to extend the kingdom of God among the nations.

2024 Highlight: The inauguration of Dr. Daniel Overdorf as the eighth president of Johnson University. Also, hosted the Student Leadership Conference in January.



NORTH FLORIDA CHRISTIAN CAMP

Seeks to create an atmosphere that helps both youth and adults focus their attention on the Lord Jesus Christ.

2024 Highlight: Celebrated its 60th anniversary and conducted seven summer camp weeks with 1,620 campers and volunteers.



PIONEER BIBLE TRANSLATORS

Bringing people to Jesus through Bible translation and church planting, combined with discipleship, incarnational ministry, and the use of translated Scripture.

2024 Highlight: Drafted the entire Bible into Juba Arabic and printed 5 Bible books for the first time.



PR 22:6

Strengthen and support Dominican Republic churches by providing Christian education materials to train, equip, and encourage youth to serve within the local churches and nurture the growth of future leaders.

2024 Highlight: Supporting 15 churches with Christian Educational materials to support their children's programming.



RAPHA HOUSE

Exists to serve children who have been impacted by trafficking and trauma, and equip families and communities to keep children safe.

2024 Highlight: Served more than a thousand children who were victims of trafficking and abuse.

CHRIST IN YOUTH

Partners with the local church to create moments and conversations that call young people to follow Jesus and into lives of Kingdom work.

2024 Highlight: Served a total of 81,283 students across 95 events throughout 51 U.S. cities and 8 countries worldwide. Creekside had 137 students attend CIY MIX and MOVE. One hundred high school students attended MOVE. Four students committed to full time ministry, 15 baptisms, and 24 students stood to state they are turning back/rededicating their life to Jesus. Thirty-seven students attended MIX resulting in 7 baptisms on site, 3 after camp, and 13 students stood to state they are turning back/rededicating their life to Jesus.



SAFE HAVENS

Safe Haven's collects and redirects gently used home furniture and furnishings so that struggling families can focus on independent living, serving refugees of all races and religions.

2024 Highlight: Safe Havens provided furnishings for approximately 50 families this year, the majority of them being refugees from Afghanistan, Syria, and Myanmar. In addition, furnishings were provided for several faith-based recovery houses and for several indigent elderly residents.
