Pray Through These Passages:

Mon. 1 Timothy 2:1-6 — Pray for leaders and the salvation of all people.
Tues. Jeremiah 29:7 — Seek the welfare of your city.
Wed. Matthew 28:18-20 — The Great Commission.
Thurs. Luke 10:2 — Pray for workers for the harvest.
Fri. Romans 10:1, 13-15 — Pray for the salvation of the lost.
Sat. 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 — Our ministry of reconciliation.
Sun. Colossians 4:2-6 — Pray for open doors to share Christ.

Challenge 1: Prayer Walk Your Neighborhood

Walk your neighborhood and pray for the homes, families, schools, and businesses you pass. Invite another church family to join you.

Challenge 2: Pray Before You Go. Before leaving home each day, pray: "Lord, open my eyes to someone who needs Your love today." Watch for opportunities to encourage or share your faith.

Challenge 3: Pray & Bless - Ask one neighbor, coworker, classmate, or server, "How can I pray for you?" Pray with them if appropriate or pray for them later and follow up during the week.
