Backpack Project - part of Seeds of Love Ministry

Our Mission - To compassionately serve those in need and share the love of Christ by providing critical items and restoring dignity through utilization of our time, talents, and treasures.

Our Vision - Planting seeds, spreading love, growing hope.

Seeds of Love strategically stretches donated funds to assist approximately 200 homeless, displaced, and low-income individuals each month within Northeast Florida.

We strive to uplift, encourage, and restore dignity to those we serve by providing new items. Our recipients light-up with delight using this "brand new only" approach. In everything we do and provide, we want them to know they are a first thought, not an afterthought.

We also collaborate with aligned nonprofits and organizations through monthly community events to increase the value of our combined impact. Our annual Back-to-School outreach is a significant initiative where we equip children with backpacks, school supplies, shoes, and clothing, empowering them for a successful start to the school year!

In 2025, at the July event, we're thrilled to share that 1,950 backpacks filled with supplies were distributed, 1,202 pairs of brand-new shoes, and new clothing for 1,120 students! But that's not all—over 1,500 bags of food and 1,300 breakfast sandwiches were provided, along with 28 haircuts and 36 school physicals and vision screenings.

This great undertaking wouldn't have been possible without the support of more than 45 sponsors and community partners (like TRBC), along with the 140 amazing volunteers and behind-the-scenes financial supporters. Together, a total of 2,333 guests were served! TRBC, you helped to make a difference!

Each case presented for assistance is run through the Elder board and must be approved by them. Documentation is gathered and the candidates are vetted before assistance is given.



BRONCOS GIVE BACK



A team of Middleburg High School employees collaborate together and identify the individual needs of students in order to come up with a plan to help provide anything they need.

Friday Bags - Identified students can receive a bag filled with food and/or hygiene items to take home on Fridays for that weekend. Students then bring us the empty bags on Monday so we can fill them again for the next week's rotation.

Holiday help - Family food baskets; bag gifts (blankets or winter clothing items) Candy bag with gift card.

Senior Activities - Camp and gown paid for or at a discounted rate. Graduation day attire like slacks, ties, and shoes or dress. Some students if the need is there we offer to pay for their senior field trip and prom.

School Supplies - Make sure students have essential school supplies to get them through the school year. Examples include backpacks, notebooks, pens, pencils, index cards, project paper, etc.

We offer God's encouragement, comfort, and hope for the hurting (Rom 8:17-18; Rom 12:15; 2 Cor 1:3-8), encourage repentance and reconciliation when necessary (Isa 30:15; Acts 3:19; 2 Cor 7:9-10), and do so in love, modeling the compassion of Christ (Jn 3:4; 13:34-35; Heb 4:14-16).
