Our Food Pantry is one of the most powerful ways we care for our neighbors, keeping shelves stocked and bringing hope directly to local families in need. Physical donations can be dropped off at any time in the Food Pantry Donations box in the lobby, or you can choose to give financially.

Essential Food Items (Per-Bag Targets)

To help us build complete, balanced grocery bags for families, we aim to include specific quantities:

- Canned Vegetables (4 cans)
- Cans of Soup (4 cans)
- Ramen Noodles (4 packages)
- Shelf-Stable / Powdered Milk (4 sm / 1 lg)
- Bottled Water (4 bottles)
- Canned Beans (3 cans)
- Mac & Cheese (3 boxes)
- Canned Fruit (2 cans)
- Snack Items (Varied fruit cups, granola bars, trail mix, cookies, etc.)
- Canned Meat (2 small / 1 large)
- Canned Tuna (2 small / 1 large)
- Cornbread Mix (2 small / 1 large)
- Peanut Butter (1 jar, 16 oz)
- Jelly (1 jar, 18 oz, any flavor)
- Breakfast Cereal (1 box or bag)
- Crackers (1 large sleeve)
- Instant Oatmeal (6-8 envelopes)

Highly Welcomed Special Items

- Toiletries & Personal Care: Toilet paper, soap, shampoo, and hygiene items
- Beverages: Coffee and tea
- Pet Food: Dog food and cat food
