### Embrace Christian Academy

- Our 5-day feeding program remains fully functional and successful.
- Academic performance continues to stay strong across all grade levels (K-9).

### Church Update: Embrace Fellowship

- Pray with us for both numerical growth and spiritual depth within the congregation.
- Pastor Alex Nynnepo (brother of Doris Sackor) continues to serve faithfully as Senior Pastor.

# CENTER FACILITY

>>> We are encouraged by how the Center continues to serve the surrounding community. Recent groups include:

- **Bible College on Wheels** — New partner using the facility for two-week sessions, three times per year. Their recent cohort included 45 students, all of whom expressed gratitude for the quality of our overnight accommodations.
- **Eagle Girls** — Ministry to young women ages 19–25, offering biblical teaching and life-skills training. Their most recent stay included 40–50 participants over four days and nights.
- **Christian Aid** — Hosts teacher-training courses and recently brought 60 teachers from the Monrovia area for a five-day training. They anticipate expanded work with high-risk youth, using the Center for daytime programming. Many of these youth currently live nearby in a Christian Aid group home.
- Numerous area churches continue to reserve the Center for midweek retreats and conferences, returning to their home congregations by Friday.

## ANTHONY'S NEXT TRIP

<<< DECEMBER 6, 2025 – MARCH 7, 2026

The priority for this upcoming trip is the much-needed replacement of deteriorating wooden trusses and zinc roofing on the main auditorium. Due to ongoing leakage and age-related damage, contractors have recommended a steeper roof pitch and complete truss restructuring.



### The auditorium project includes:

- Replace wooden trusses & install new metal roof

**Estimated Cost = \$15,000**

- Replace existing plywood ceiling with non-porous sheeting & aluminum support framing

**Estimated Cost = \$17,000**

This renovation is essential to protect and extend the life of the Center for future ministry and educational work.
