1. Are you more inclined to confront OR avoid the offenses OR sins of others? What influences your response to people's sin OR personal offense?
2. What is the progression of confronting a fellow believer who is unrepentant of their sin? In what way can you recognize God's grace in this progression?
3. Would you say that this is a consistently practiced protocol in the local church? Why or Why not?
4. How does confronting the sin of a fellow believer communicate that you love/value them? What does ignoring their sin communicate?
5. How does confronting someone's sin protect the church? How does dismissing someone's sin negatively affect the church?
6. Is there someone that you need to confront privately OR take another person with you?
7. What is one truth in all these truths that you are taking to heart to follow through?
