Sermon Discussion Questions

Please take a few minutes after the service today to discuss together the following questions with whom you are gathered.

1. What does it practically mean to “love your neighbor as yourself” (Matthew 22:39)? How is this different from simply being nice to people?
2. Why do you think it can sometimes be easier to love people in general than to love specific people in our everyday lives?
3. Think about the question: “If I were in their situation, what would I hope someone would do for me?” How could that question change the way we respond to people around us?
4. Who has God placed in your life right now who may need to experience His love through you? What is one specific way you could demonstrate love to that person this week?
5. What makes loving our neighbor difficult—whether it is inconvenience, busyness, conflict, fear, or something else? How can the love of Christ help us overcome those barriers?
