5. In your opinion, who in scripture exercised the strongest faith? Why did you pick this particular person?
6. When people share their stories of faith, how does it impact you?
7. According to Hebrews 11, there are many stories of faith, but what is the common denominator?
8. How does faith come into play when Jesus says in John 15:5 “apart from me, you can do nothing”?
9. How do you exercise daily faith?
10. Is it difficult to maintain faith when the answer from God seems slow?
What do you do to keep faith during the waiting period?
11. Is faith based on the size of your faith or the size of your God?
12. How do you respond to people when they say “If you had more faith your situation would change”?
