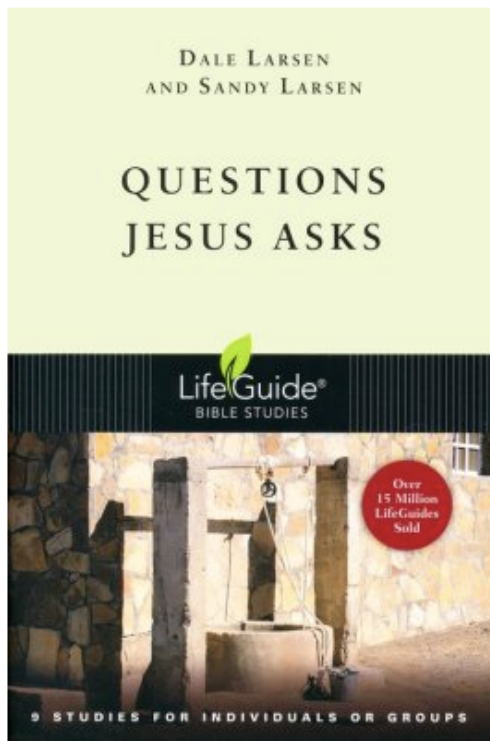

Imaginative Prayer

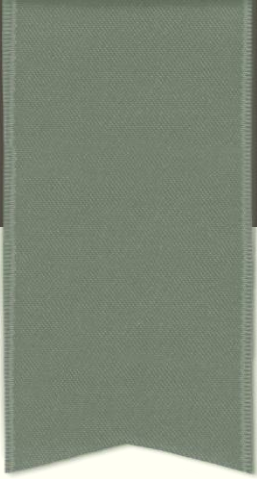
- Ask for the Holy Spirit's help.
- Read the passage over a few times.
- Close your eyes, and try to imagine it all.
- Place yourself in the scene, and try to imagine the sights, the sounds, the smells, the feeling of being there.
- Allow the scene you imagine to lead you into a conversation with the Lord.

Inductive Bible study

- Inductive reasoning: moves from specific details to a general conclusion. (Deductive reasoning moves from general to specific.)
- Three steps:
 - Observation (What does the text say?)
 - Interpretation (What does the text mean?)
 - Application (What does the text mean for my life?)

Questions Jesus Asks

- Suggested four-days-a-week format:
 - 1) Read the intro text in the workbook, then read the whole chapter (e.g., John 1 for next week), then pray imaginatively with the passage.
 - 2) Answer the first half of the questions.
 - 3) Answer the second half of the questions.
 - 4) Read over the passage and what you have written one more time.
- If you have more time and would like to go deeper, try the “Now or Later” suggestions at the end of each chapter.
