Accredited Units of Study

Faith and Purpose

ACA001

Explore the foundations of Christian faith and how belief shapes worldview, meaning, and purpose. Students reflect on their own faith journey and examine how faith informs identity, vocation, and human flourishing.

New Testament Foundations

BIB010

Study the life of Jesus, the early Church, and the writings that shape Christian faith. This unit explores historical and cultural context and reveals the unified message of the New Testament.

Introduction to Pastoral Ministry

MIN001

A foundational exploration of pastoral calling, care, and ministry practice. Topics include contemporary pastoral models, conflict resolution, caregiving, and ministry ethics.

Introduction to Theology

THE005

Engage with the core doctrines of the Christian faith, including the Trinity, creation, Christology, and the Kingdom of God. Students develop theological clarity and confidence.

Old Testament Foundations

BIB009

An introduction to the Old Testament as God's unfolding self-revelation. Students explore its themes, theology, wisdom, and narrative, discovering its relevance for discipleship and ministry today.

Character Formation and Ministry

MIN012

Focuses on spiritual formation and integrity in ministry. Students explore Christian spirituality, healthy rhythms, boundaries, and sustainable ministry practices.

Leadership Principles

LEA005

Explores leadership through contemporary theory and a Christian worldview. Students develop practical leadership skills in communication, team building, ethics, and adaptability.

Professional Practice

EXP001

An internship-based unit integrating theory with practice. Students complete a 100-hour supervised placement (or two 50-hour placements), gaining real-world ministry experience.
