We continue to be amazed at how God has used your generosity through Kingdom Builders to make an eternal impact in our city and across the world. Because of your faithfulness, our nine campuses are feeding more people, partnering with more schools, and engaging in more community outreaches than ever before. Globally, we have continued to support 140 missionary partners in 60 countries, built four churches overseas, hosted a medical clinic in Ecuador, and sent both our Junior High and Senior High students on mission trips.

As we look to the Great Commission and the enormity of the unfinished task, we are reminded that there is still much to do. In 2026, we will continue to Love Our City through every campus. Already, seven mission trips, including youth, construction, and medical, are scheduled for next year.

God is also blessing our campuses with health and growth. As a result, over the next five years, we will need to build new sanctuaries in Ridgeville and Santee. In Moncks Corner, all engineering and architectural plans for expansion are complete, and we are awaiting final permits from Berkeley County. We anticipate breaking ground soon. Because design and permitting take time, we will

also begin that process next year for Ridgeville. In addition, we are excited to announce the launch of our 10th campus in St. George in 2026.

Everything we have accomplished has only been through the goodness of God and the faithful generosity of His people. The year ahead presents a larger financial challenge than ever before, but we serve a big God who is more than able to provide. We ask you to prayerfully consider your Kingdom Builders commitment for 2026.



PLAN


DREAM

As a pastor, missionary, and educator, Dr. Easter is passionate about mobilizing the next generation for frontier missions. Serving in Africa for 22 years, he trained church planters and missionaries to carry the Gospel across the continent. His crossgenerational focus extends intimately to his family. John and Cheryl are deeply devoted to their children: Kevin, John-John, and his wife, Calissa; and Mitchell, his wife, Alyssa, and their four children.
