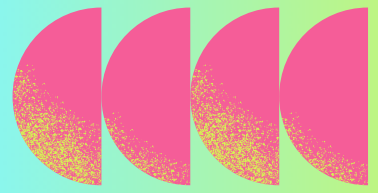


SERMON GUIDE

MEMORY VERSE

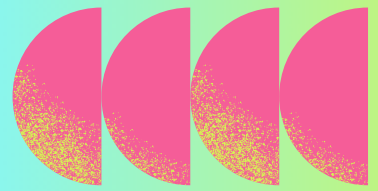
OVER THE COURSE OF THIS SERIES, OUR GOAL IS TO MEMORIZE THE FOLLOWING VERSE FROM THE BIBLE : 2 CORINTHIANS 3:18

SERMON SUMMARY

ISAIAH'S VISION REMINDS US THAT WHEN WE LOOK AT GOD, WE ARE FIRST AWESTRUCK BY HIS UNMATCHED HOLINESS AND GLORY. IN THE LIGHT OF GOD'S PRESENCE, ISAIAH BECAME DEEPLY AWARE OF HIS OWN SINFULNESS AND CRIED OUT IN HUMILITY, SHOWING US THAT GENUINE ENCOUNTERS WITH GOD LEAD TO HONEST CONFESSION. YET GOD'S PURPOSE IS NOT MERELY TO EXPOSE OUR SIN BUT TO CLEANSE IT, AS HE GRACIOUSLY REMOVED ISAIAH'S GUILT AND RESTORED HIM THROUGH HIS PROVISION. ONCE CLEANSED, ISAIAH WAS READY TO ANSWER GOD'S CALL AND BE SENT ON HIS MISSION, TRUSTING GOD BEFORE HE KNEW THE OUTCOME. WHEN WE LOOK AT GOD, WE ARE AWESTRUCK BY HIS GLORY, UNDONE BY HIS HOLINESS, CLEANSED BY HIS GRACE, AND SENT BY HIS MISSION.

PRAYER

LORD, YOU ARE HOLY, AND YOUR GLORY FILLS THE EARTH. THANK YOU THAT YOU DO NOT LEAVE US OR ABANDON US. YOU CLEANSE US, YOU RESTORE US, AND YOU CALL US BY NAME. LIKE ISAIAH, MAY WE RESPOND WITH OPEN HANDS: HERE I AM. SEND ME. TRANSFORM US BY THE SIGHT OF YOUR GLORY, AND USE US FOR YOUR MISSION. AMEN.



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DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. DID YOU DO THE LOOK AT GOD CHALLENGE LAST WEEK? HOW WAS YOUR EXPERIENCE AND WHAT DID YOU LEARN OR ENCOUNTER IN YOUR TIME?
2. WHAT STOOD OUT TO YOU MOST ABOUT THE SERMON THIS SUNDAY?
3. WHAT DETAILS IN ISAIAH 6:1-4 COMMUNICATE GOD'S HOLINESS, MAJESTY, AND AUTHORITY?
4. HOW DOES THE PROGRESSION OF THE PASSAGE—FROM AWE, TO CONFESSION, TO CLEANSING, TO SENDING—HELP US UNDERSTAND HOW GOD WORKS IN THE LIVES OF HIS PEOPLE?
5. ISAIAH STOPPED COMPARING HIMSELF TO OTHER PEOPLE AND MEASURED HIMSELF AGAINST GOD'S HOLINESS. HOW DOES THAT CHALLENGE THE WAY YOU NORMALLY EVALUATE YOURSELF?
6. WHAT IS ONE PRACTICAL WAY YOU CAN INTENTIONALLY "LOOK AT GOD" THIS WEEK RATHER THAN FOCUSING ON YOUR CIRCUMSTANCES?
7. WHERE MIGHT GOD BE ASKING YOU TO SAY, "HERE AM I. SEND ME," EVEN IF YOU DO NOT KNOW ALL THE DETAILS?

WEEKLY CHALLENGE

CONTINUE MAKING ENTRIES IN YOUR JOURNAL. AND LET'S CONTINUE TO BUILD ON OUR JOURNALING BY CHALLENGING YOURSELF TO IDENTIFY A PERSON IN YOUR LIFE WHO HAS DEMONSTRATED GOD'S PRESENCE AND LOVE TO YOU AND SHARE THAT WITH THAT PERSON. TELL THEM HOW YOU HAVE SEEN GOD THROUGH THEM. WRITE ABOUT IT IN YOUR JOURNAL. YOU CAN ALSO VISIT THE PRAYER ROOM (ROOM 145) AT ANY POINT DURING THIS SERIES. THIS IS MEANT TO BE A SHORT INTERACTIVE EXPERIENCE WITH GUIDED PRAYER, REFLECTION, AND A MOMENT TO FOCUS ON GOD.
