## WEEK 3: How Does God Speak to Us?

**MAIN IDEAS:** God speaks to us in many ways: the Bible (2 Timothy 3:16), Creation (Psalm 19:1-4), the Holy Spirit (Acts 16:6-10), other people (prophets, judges, apostles, etc.).

**WORSHIP:** Sing with the children the song, "Pray About Everything"

**REFLECT:** Remind children about our lesson from last week. Build a connection to this week: How did God create everything? (He spoke it into being)

**ACTIVITY:** Children work to complete Bible code activity.

### DISCUSSION:

- How do we communicate?
- How can you deliver a message without speaking?
- How does God speak to us?

**SCRIPTURE:** Read the following passages and lead discussion about how God is speaking to us in each example.

- 2 Timothy 3:16 - The Bible
- Psalm 19:1-4 - Creation
- Acts 16:6-10 - the Holy Spirit
- Share how God has spoken to you in your own life through other people (parents, teachers, pastors, coaches, friends, etc.) and allow space for kids to share how he is speaking in their lives.

### DISCUSSION:

- How can we talk to God?

**ACTIVITY:** Work with children to write, draw, or speak a prayer using the prayer prompts.

**PRAYER:** Lead group in prayer using prayer prompts.
