WEEK 9: Why And How Should I Tell Others?

MAIN IDEA: How do I tell others about Jesus?

WORSHIP: Sing with the children, "Go Tell it on the Mountain!"

REFLECT: Remind children about our lesson from last week.

- God wants us to share our toys and our hugs with those around us.
- Even if we don't want to give up something important to us, God promises we'll be ok if we share.

SCRIPTURE: Read 1 Peter 3:15 with the children.

- "...Honor Christ as Lord. Be ready at all times to explain the hope you have in Him.

DISCUSSION:

- Talk with the children about how God has equipped us perfectly to share their story with others. Jesus gave us ideas about how to share our story. Matthew 5:13-16.
- Sing "This Little Light of Mine."
- I can show my family and friends about how Jesus is in my life by:
 - sharing my toys
 - always choosing kindness
 - telling the truth,
 - not retaliating to someone who has done something wrong to you
 - telling friends about the love of Jesus

ACTIVITY:

- Blow bubbles (use a bottle of pre-made bubble mixture) with the children. Each time they stomp on a bubble, ask them to shout ideas related to the lesson. (e.g., I love Jesus! Go tell it on the mountain! I am going to let it shine!)

PRAYER: Dear God, thank you for loving me! Please help me to remember to tell my family and friends how much I love you! Amen.
