WEEK 8: How Does God View Money?

MAIN IDEA: Everything belongs to God and we are to be stewards of all of it

REFLECT: Remind your child about what was learned last week about compassion. Did they have any new thoughts about what was learned?

SCRIPTURE: Read Matthew 6:19-21 Nlrv or MSG

DISCUSSION:

- What are treasures / riches?
- What does it look like to store up treasures in Heaven?

ACTIVITY: Scavenger Hunt

- Take your children outside and share a reminder with them that God made everything, owns everything, and cares for everything.
- Go on a scavenger hunt for the following:
 - Something God made that you can see
 - Something God made that you can smell
 - Something God made that you can touch
 - Something God made that you can taste
 - Something God made that you can hear
- Come back inside and share that all the stuff we have inside belongs to God too. We need to take care of the things God has given us outside and the things God has given us inside.

ACTIVITY: The Power of Sharing

- Read John 6:1-13 together. Ask your children who they think are people who are generous, (share their things). How do those people show their generosity? Ask your children why sharing is important, then encourage them to come up ways they can share with people in need.

DISCUSSION: Talk about the ideas your children came up with to share with people in need. How can you as a family complete one of those ideas this week

PRAYER: Heavenly Father, thank you for making everything. Thank you for giving us exactly what we need. Please help us take care of all the things you have given us and to share with others. In Jesus' name, Amen.
