

# WHAT TO WEAR 2025

## GENERAL GUIDELINES (This is for choir only, orchestra/tech in all black)

Primary color – Burgundy (not red or cranberry but burgundy!), Dark Green (not Kelly green or sage green, think forest green) and Navy Blue.

Secondary/accent color – Gold (not yellow, not mustard, something with shine but no sequins)

Our goal is to avoid anything that might distract from the message—whether it's clothing that's too light or dark, bare legs in the front row, or noticeable white socks/undershirt. We'll work to maintain a uniform appearance while still allowing room for personal style. If you have any questions about colors, what to wear or if you are unsure, talk to Kim or bring your items before Dec 7<sup>th</sup>.

## MEN

Top – preferably burgundy, dark green or navy-blue shirt but black is ok if unable to purchase color. (no white undershirts or socks, black socks only).

Bottom – black

Accessories – colored ties or suspenders are great! Mix and match colors, i.e. burgundy shirt with dark green suspenders. This is where you can add gold to your outfit.

## WOMEN

Top - preferably burgundy, dark green or navy top, if wearing a cardigan (colored) or top the top that needs a cami or tank, black is ok. Solid black is ok if you are accenting with the above colors.

Bottom - no bare legs— black bottoms preferred, opaque tights

Accessories – scarves, jewelry, etc. This is where you can add gold to your outfit as well.

No sleeveless or short sleeve (to elbow or below)

Please be aware of low-neck lines as well as sheer fabric will be exposed with the spotlights more than anticipated. Please wear tank underneath. It is shocking what we can see once the lights come on.
