WEEK 7: How Can I Make the Most of My Life? (Part 2)

MAIN IDEA: Caring for and loving those around you.

REFLECT: What fun things did you do to serve your family last week?

SCRIPTURE: Read Matthew 25:40, Luke 10: 25-37 (The Parable of the Good Samaritan.)

DISCUSSION: How can we love those around us that are in need like the Good Samaritan?

ACTIVITY: Kindness Flower

- Give your child a cutout circle for the center of the flower and six petals.
- Ask your child to think of ways that they can help others.
- Write one way they are kind, helpful or compassionate on each petal.
- Have them glue the center of the flower on a piece of construction paper and arrange the petals around it, gluing them down.
- Your child(ren) can draw a stem and decorate the rest of their paper.

DISCUSSION: Talk to your child about the flower and how you can make these things happen as a family.

PRAYER: Dear Lord, we are thankful for your love for us. Help us to love our neighbors and those around us just as you love us. Amen.
