WEEK 2: Who Is God?

MAIN IDEA: God is bigger than any image we have of Him.

We get to know God...

- Through our world
- Through Jesus
- Through scripture

The world was made by God for us. God created us to be in a relationship with Him.

WORSHIP: Sing with the children the song, "God is so good!"

REFLECT: Remind children about our lesson from last week, "I will do what I say."

Play the following "Show Me" game:

- Show me what it looks like when you say you will pick up your toys.
- Show me what it looks like when you say you will eat all of your breakfast.
- Show me what it looks like when you say you will stay in bed at night.

Doing what you say is called a promise. God promises to love us.

SCRIPTURE: Use a children's Bible to read Psalm 104:24 aloud with the children.

ACTIVITY: Show an image of a variety of animals, an image of day and night, and an image of the sun, moon, and stars. (See examples)

- Talk with children about what they notice.
- Remind children that these are all examples of God's creations.
- Pass around a mirror and have the children look at themselves one at a time.
- Ask: What do you see?
- Remind children "The most special creation is You!"
- Sing and play "Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes."
- Remind students that each part of them is special and God loves them

PRAYER: Dear Creator God, thank you so much for creating everything in this world. From the littlest insects to the biggest animals. You thought about and created them all and You created them all with purpose...just like me. I pray that I can continue to learn about all that You have created. Thank God for all the things that He has created...especially you. Amen.
