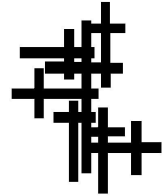


**Good Shepherd Pastoral Council**

- Pastoral Care Commission - No Liaison needed given Pastoral Care Coordinator and Pastor request to not hold Pastoral Care Commission monthly meetings

  - Cheryl is doing much and doing it well
  - It's possible that we will amend the Norms to not have a Pastoral Care Commission for 2024-2025
  - The ministries like quilters, card ministry, Prayer Corner, would continue to move on. They keep Cheryl updated
  - Cheryl will work with Sandy in their weekly check-in meetings regarding communication to Bryan for the bulletin, and members of Pastoral Care Ministries
