2. God's Priority (vv. 13-19)

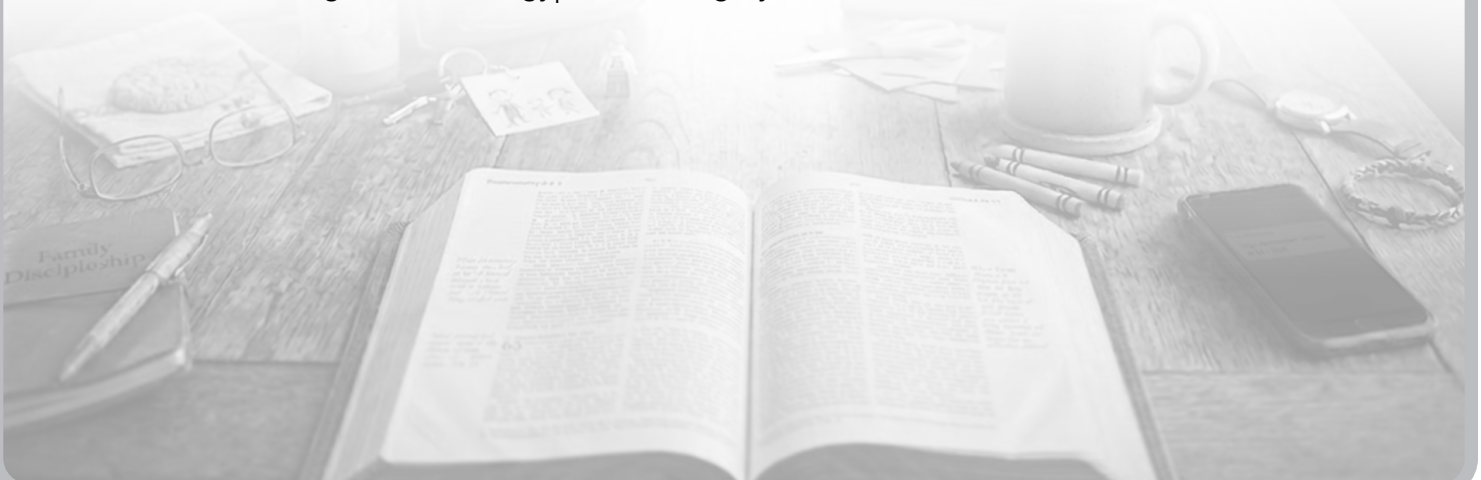
Leave a legacy of _____ faithful to God alone.

3. God's Plan (vv. 20-25)

Leave a legacy of _____ what God has done.

"...you shall say to your son, 'We were Pharaoh's slaves in Egypt. And the Lord brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand.'"



FAITH-FORMING PRACTICE

Tell Stories of God

This week, share one story of God's faithfulness with someone in your home, family, or church family.

- **REMEMBER:** Think of one specific way God has provided, corrected, carried, or saved you.
- **RETELL:** Share that story with someone in your home, family, or church family.
- **RESPOND:** End by praying together: "Lord, help us remember Your faithfulness and follow You with all our hearts."

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

1. In Deut. 6:10–12, why do you think comfort and blessing can make people forget the Lord?
2. What is one specific provision of God in your life that you do not want the next generation to forget?
3. Deut. 6:13–19 calls God's people to fear, serve, and worship Him alone. What are some "other gods" that compete for the loyalty of our homes today? How can we warn and protect our family (physical or spiritual) against it?
4. In Deut. 6:20–25, the child asks a question, and the parent answers with a story of redemption. How can we become the kind of church family where younger people seek out the older to ask honest questions and receive honest answers?
5. What is one step you can take this week to leave a legacy worth leaving in your home, family, or church family?
