

Photography & Video Recording Policy

As part of our ministries, services, events, and programs, photography and video recording may take place. Images and recordings may be used for purposes such as ministry documentation, education, reporting, and Church communications, including promotional and pastoral materials.

Consent

By participating in Church services, events, or programs where photography or video recording occurs, you consent to the collection, use, disclosure, and storage of your personal information in accordance with this Notice and the [Anglican Church Southern Queensland Privacy Policy](#).

Right to Refuse or Withdraw Consent

Participation is voluntary. You may refuse or withdraw consent for photography or video recording at any time.

To opt out, you may:

- Notify the photographer or a staff member at the time of the service or event who will then note your name and contact; and/or
- Provide written notice by emailing the appropriate Church contact to request refusal, limitation, redaction, or removal of images or recordings.

Once notice is received, reasonable steps will be taken to ensure no further images are captured and, where possible/necessary, existing images or recordings are not used or are removed.

Consent

The Church Body collects, uses, holds, and discloses personal information in accordance with the **Privacy Act 1988 (Cth)** and the **Australian Privacy Principles (APPs)**.

We recognize and respect diverse cultural, personal, and lived experiences. All content is captured thoughtfully and with care. Concerns or preferences are always welcome and will be addressed respectfully.
