These groups are focused on spiritual growth, meeting at various times. Groups provide the opportunity to know others and be known, as well as supporting others in their walk with Christ.

WHAT IS A DISCIPLESHIP GROUP?

A Discipleship Group is a small group of believers made up of two to four people of the same gender who meet regularly to encourage each other and help one another to follow Jesus.

HOW OFTEN SHOULD I MEET?

Discipleship Groups can meet every week or every other week depending on schedules. How long each meeting goes is up to the group. Groups can also choose to meet during the summer or throughout the year.

WHY SHOULD I SEEK OUT OTHERS TO MEET WITH?

Spiritual growth does not happen automatically in our lives. We need regular rhythms that center us on God's Word and sharpen us with the encouragement of fellow believers. A Discipleship Group is an ideal environment for both of these things to happen.

THE PURPOSE OF DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS

Discipleship Groups meet regularly to do the following things:

To know & be known by each other

These groups provide the space to be open about the ups and downs of life. Your group should take the time to confess sin and to encourage each other in your obedience to Christ.

To read the bible together

Discipleship Groups are a great place to be encouraged to regularly read God's word. Your group can arrange to read the same Bible reading plan, so you can discuss what you have read together.

To apply Scripture to each other's lives

Gathering with a couple believers allows for time to talk about how Scripture applies to life. Your group can speak about what you are learning from Scripture and how it should affect how you live.

To pray with and for one another

A big part of following Christ is regularly communicating with God and relying on Him. Your group should pray for each other's needs and for individual growth in godliness.
