

The **Generation-to-Generation (G2G)** Committee prepared and provided you with the brochure **Leaving a Legacy** as we celebrate the birthday of the church each year on Pentecost Sunday.

The Generation-to-Generation Fund multiplies the blessings of planned gifts and bequests by current generations to make a difference for future generations. A periodic gift from you, or a bequest from your estate, demonstrates your gratitude for the gifts God has given you. All these gifts help St. Mark continue sharing the good news of God's love by supporting the many ministry programs, weekly worship services, mission and outreach activities, and facility needs.

The stock markets have been more favorable this year which influenced most investment portfolios. These are long-term investments in the Texas Presbyterian Fund with the key strategy to stay invested to be positioned to achieve future financial gains. 
