The Generation-to-Generation Fund multiplies the blessings of planned gifts and bequests by current generations to make a difference for future generations.

A periodic gift from you, or a bequest from your estate, demonstrates your gratitude for the gifts God has given you. All these gifts help St. Mark continues sharing the good news of God's love by supporting the many ministry programs, weekly worship services, mission and outreach activities, and facility needs.

The stock markets have been more favorable this year which influenced most investment portfolios. We maintain long-term investments in the Texas Presbyterian Foundation with the key strategy to stay invested to be positioned to achieve future financial gains. Below are the fund balances for the G2G Endowment accounts:

Thanks to the generosity of the Penrod family a new restricted fund named as the **Compassion Fund – IMO Thelma Jean Penrod** was established with \$5,000 in the Texas Presbyterian Foundation in June 2025. With additional contributions and dividends, its current value is **\$7,048.91** which is reflected in the total above. Future contributions and earned dividends will be used by the Pastor and Deacons to aid the elderly of St. Mark in their times of need.
