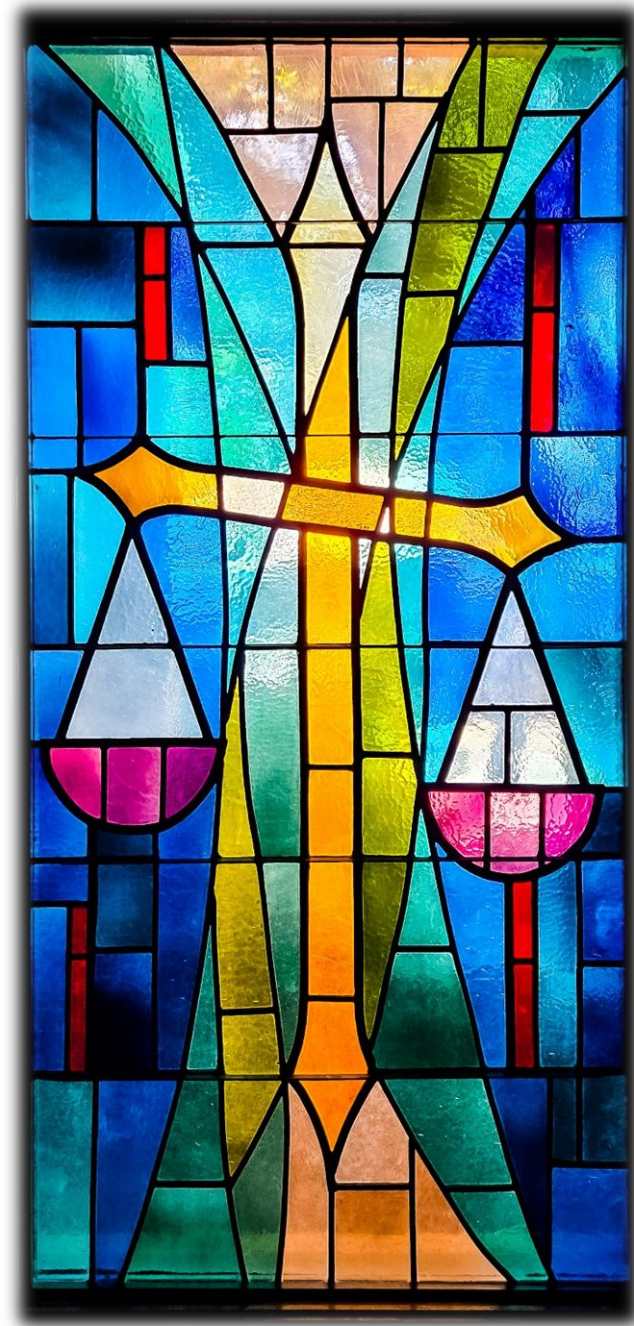
Called Congregational Meeting
