POSITION SUMMARY

The Associate Pastor of Music and Worship will report directly to the Senior Pastor and work in harmony with the entire ministerial staff. This person should have a firm grasp on the purpose, values, and strategy of FBCG and work to align key leadership teams with its mission.

WORSHIP LEADER PROFILE

- Quality singing voice and engaging stage presence (ability to play instrument is preferred)
- Worship Leader (and family, if applicable) should integrate into FBCG's church body by participating in Life Groups and becoming an active member.
- Experience with use of technology in worship, mixer board, lighting, worship software, and sound systems
- Team player with good relational skills
- Has a servant's heart
- Eager and willing to serve all generations within a multigenerational congregation

EXPECTED PERFORMANCE

- Communicate the truth of God's Word
- Serve as Lead Associate Pastor at the discretion of the Senior Pastor
- Support FBCG in the accomplishment of the church's mission through worship ministry
- Under supervision of the Senior Pastor, develop, coordinate, and implement Sunday Morning worship service(s)
- Recruit and develop volunteers to assist in worship and music ministry
- Oversee the planning and execution of the worship ministry including the production aspects of all services
- Participate in a comprehensive mission strategy that seeks to accomplish the mandate of Acts 1:8
- Take responsibility for assigned budget preparation and administration
- Exercise effective administrative skills and management skills
