Welcome

Thank you for being a part of this 24-hour prayer event!

Your commitment to pray is a vital part of our shared vision to see people come to Jesus and for lives to be transformed by His love.

This event centres on prayer for conversions and church planting seeking God's direction, wisdom, and empowerment as we seek to be a church that brings people to Jesus, both as individuals and a community.

At the same time, we recognise that the Holy Spirit often stirs hearts in different ways. You are warmly invited to pray for whatever God places on your heart for our church, our community, or the wider world.

We trust that as we pray together, God will renew our hearts, speak to us, and send us out in faith.

Your reflections will also help our leadership team discern what God may be saying to us as a church.

Purpose

We believe that prayer is the foundation for everything God calls us to do at Seeds. Through this 24-hour prayer event, we are:

- Praying for conversions that lead to baptisms and growing disciples
- Seeking God's heart for church planting, where, when and how He might be calling us to plant new church families.
- Praying for our recent church plants – Seeds Kurralta Park and Seeds Hallett Cove
- Asking God to raise up leaders, teams, and resources for new ministry.
- Listening for what the Holy Spirit is saying to Seeds Church at this time.
- Bringing any other prayers or burdens the Spirit prompts for renewal, healing, justice, or anything else close to God's heart.

Prepare

Before you begin:

Find a quiet place to centre yourself in God's presence.

Read a passage of Scripture such as Matthew 9:35–38, 1 Thess 1: 2-10, or 1 Cor 3: 1-15

Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you, to guide both your prayers and your listening.

Remember, prayer is not about performance or productivity, it's about presence.

Take time to listen as well as speak.

Resources

You are welcome to pray as you feel led. Many Christians follow an ACTS prayer model. This can be a helpful starting point if you don't know where to begin.

A – Adoration

Begin by praising God for who He is, His character, His greatness, His love, His power.

C – Confession

Confess your sins honestly before God. Acknowledge where you've fallen short and receive His forgiveness.

T – Thanksgiving

Express gratitude for answered prayers, blessings, relationships, provision, or anything God has done in your life and the life of Seeds. You might want to give thanks to God for particular ministries of Seeds that have been a blessing to you. Thank God for His faithfulness to Seeds Church. Thank Him for the people who have come to faith, for growth, and for the ongoing work of the Spirit.

S – Supplication

Bring your requests to God.

Focus Areas

Key areas of focus for this season in the life of Seeds are:

Conversions that Lead to Baptisms

- Pray for at least 50 conversions that lead to baptisms across the Seeds churches.

Church Planting and Mission

- Pray for clarity about where God may be calling us to plant new churches or missional communities.
- Ask for open doors and hearts ready to receive the good news.

Leadership and Teams

- Pray for future church planters, leaders, and teams for vision, humility, courage and unity.
- Ask God to sustain and guide current leaders as they discern next steps.

Focus Areas

Key areas of focus for this season in the life of Seeds are:

Renewal of Seeds Church

- Pray for spiritual renewal in our community that everything we do would flow from deep love for Jesus.
- Ask that we would be a sending and blessing church, alive with hope and joy.

Broader Concerns

- Pray for the needs God places on your heart for people in our community, our nation, or across the world.
- Lift up concerns such as healing, justice, reconciliation, or peace.

Stations

Each of the below prayer stations has its own online form. You can use these forms to respond as you pray, reflect, or engage with each station.

All responses are anonymous, so you can participate freely.

As people submit their reflections, the responses from every station are collated into a single spreadsheet, which will be available for everyone to see via the link below or QR code.
