MAKING A BEQUEST IN **YOUR WILL**

A will is a document by which you are able to make gifts known as bequests to people and organisations you wish to benefit after you have passed away. One way you can support the ongoing ministry of Seeds Uniting Church is by making provision for Seeds in your will.

Through your estate you are able to make a lasting contribution towards the work of Seeds Church in our community and "Bringing people to Jesus and being transformed into His passionate disciples."

Making a will is an important step and we recommend that you seek professional advice and assistance in the preparation of such an important document.

Below is an example of wording for a clause which may be used in a will which may assist your advisors.

This clause makes a bequest to the Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (S.A) but there is a sub-clause stating that the gift is to be used for the benefit of Seeds Uniting Church.

It is the practice of the Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (S.A) to pass the bequest directly Seeds Church.

EXAMPLE WORDING FOR A CLAUSE

"I give and bequeath (description of gift, e.g. specific amount or percentage of estate or balance of estate) to The Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (S.A.)

a) for the use and benefit of Seeds Uniting Church, South Australia
ABN 89 480 342 391

b) for the purpose of
(insert the intended use of the funds - buildings, outreach, general funding etc.).

c) If this gift cannot take effect for any reason, for the use and benefit of Seeds Uniting Church, The Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (S.A.) shall pay it to the organisation which it considers most nearly fulfils the objects that I intended to benefit."
