Review

At the beginning of Paul's letter the church in Colossae, he shares a beautiful exaltation of Jesus as the center of God's creation and intent for the world. At the heart of this is a message of hope: God has reconciled all things to him through the work of Jesus Christ.

Discussion Questions

1. What thoughts or emotions do you have when you read Paul's declaration about Christ in verses 15-20?
2. Why do you think God was pleased to have His fullness dwell in Christ?
3. How does Christ's blood bring reconciliation and peace as it says in verse 20?
4. Sit with verse 21 for a few seconds. What do you think Paul meant by "Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds..."?
