Read **Romans 11:25-36** together.

Review

In chapters 9-11, Paul grapples with the lack of responsiveness to the message of Jesus Christ from his own Jewish people. What does Paul's struggle tell us about our own struggles, and how does he give us hope in the midst of this wrestling?

Discussion Questions

1. What does it mean to be grafted in to the tree of Israel? How does this affect how we view the church and our own story?
2. We read last week that nothing can separate us from the love of God; this week, we read that “God’s gifts and His call are irrevocable.” Does this affect how you see God’s faithfulness and his promises?
3. Read 11:33-36 again as a group. What sticks out to you and what does it communicate about God?
